

Ausdance Queensland Vinyl Floor Hire

Conditions of hire:

Hirers are responsible for the vinyl floor and every care should be taken to ensure that there is no damage to it.

Any damage must be reported to Ausdance Qld immediately on (07) 3122 7628.

1. The surface on which the vinyl floor is to be laid must first be **swept, then vacuumed**, as even small pieces of grit will bed into the soft material. The surface must be a flat, stable surface with no projections, depressions or rough materials to make contact with the vinyl floor.
2. The vinyl floor is extremely heavy (approx. 50kg per roll) and requires a **minimum of two strong people to handle it**. It should be transported flat, taking care that the edges of the rolls are protected at all times.
3. The vinyl floor must be under-taped. **Tape must not be affixed to the top surface** of the vinyl. The use of gaffer or naff is not allowed. We prefer Harlequin or Stylus tape be used for install.
4. Sharp, rough or hard props, which may cause damage to the vinyl floor, must not be placed on the surface. No pyrotechnics or fire may be used.
5. **No hard sole shoes are to be worn** on the vinyl floor as they will damage the surface. No taps, Spanish/Flamenco, Irish or other shoes with metal toes/heels/sharp edges.
6. **Daily cleaning is dry mopping or vacuum cleaning** to remove dust and loose dirt, followed by damp mopping once or twice a week with a mop dampened with water or detergent solution, but not leaving water on the surface. The floor should be virtually dry after 15-20 seconds.
7. The vinyl floor must be **returned clean and tightly rolled in its original bags**. No solvents are to be used in the cleaning process. On inspection, if the vinyl floor is found to require cleaning, the cleaning bond will be applied to the labour charge for cleaning.
8. The hirer is responsible for the cost of replacing any rolls of vinyl floor lost, stolen or damaged during the hire.
9. The hirer takes responsibility for injury caused to any person through the use of this equipment. We strongly recommend that your technical staff and performers are insured for injury.
10. The hirer must not allow any person onto the dance floor unless it is completely dry.
11. The hirer is responsible for collection and return of the vinyl floor from Ausdance Qld at the Judith Wright Centre of Contemporary Arts.
